More updates on the WaveRider

Email from Bill Roberts:

Just want to let you know that the WaveRider is available for production if needed. This is how we stand now and what our plans are down the road.

Since our meeting with WUA Stray Voltage committee and the Public Service Commission, which you attended, in May our goal has been in four steps.

Here are our four steps and the proposed prices for each.

STEP #1 Provide a WaveReader for Windows (WRW). This has been completed and is Version 1.01. Cost \$200.00.

STEP #2 Provide a WaveRider (logging program) for Windows program. Today the DEMO Version of this is on the WEB Page www.hbci.com/~ewbrom.com and can be

downloaded to look at. This cost will be determined soon. This also can be done via email as the WRW Program was.

STEP #3 Provide a WaveRider for Windows with software to **support true RMS**. To do this upgrade the WaveRider box will have to be returned and the following will be done.

- Replace CPU (which has a battery in it expected for 10 years life)
- Replace battery
- Install new software
- Test and repair any problems
- Final test
- Calibrate

This cost will be announced.

Note: STEP #2 has to be done before this STEP can be done.

STEP #4 Provide the total package above along with new WaveRider, Computer, in a box to be hung on the wall as requested at the WUA Meeting. We are still putting prices together for this, and the price will also depend on how many units will be ordered.

Thank you again for your support of the WaveRider, and I will keep you posted as we progress.
